Deadline

Proposal selection criteria

All proposals will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- Current, timely nature of the topic.
- Originality of material.
- Relevance and importance of topic.
- Practical application of materials.

Notifications

If you are selected to speak at the event, you will be notified approximately 6-8 weeks prior to event.
